Description of Activities:

AU Mini Marathon "Run For Love" is our first charity running event which was organized on the Valentine's Day 2016. The main purpose of this event was to promote not only good health but also harmony among students, lecturers, staffs, administrators, alumni, and the community around Bang Bo and Bang Sao Thong districts.

The race was held within Suvarnabhumi Campus of the university. There were two types of race offered; Mini-Marathon 10 kilometers and Fun Run 5 kilometers. Runners can also apply for a single or couple runs. Since the event was held on Valentine's Day, many participants joined this event with their loved ones including lovers, friends, and family members. All finishers received a T-shirt and medal. Trophies were awarded to the $1^{st} - 5^{th}$ places of pair finishers. Moreover, it was an honor that Mr. Pinij Harnphanich, Governor of Samut Prakarn Province was present during the opening ceremony.

In this event, there were several booths of sponsors giving away free samples and we also prepared some places for photo taking that runners can enjoy with. Furthermore, everyone has got involved in the charity due to the revenue from the event after expenses which worth 300,000 Baht will be donated to Thai Red Cross Society.

PART V: Discussion of Project Performance

Summary of Feedback and Comments:

- Some participants are professional runners but the majority is our students, lecturers, and staffs. Most of them were highly satisfied with this running activity.
- They have shared pictures and comments of this event via social media. Some comments include it was fun; they enjoyed scenic view along the running route; car parking and other facilities were convenient and suitable; various food and drinks were well provided.
- However, some applicants were dissatisfied with the registration process. Since there were several methods to apply for running and no linkage between the database of application and payment, some applicants' information were missing.
- Other reasons of missing data were that applicants forgot to send the evidence of payment, and they applied with one partner but paid fee with another partner.

- The delay of T-shirt delivery from the supplier caused the shortage of some shirt sizes.
- Some steps of our event planning were interrupted due to the lack of prior discussion with the hired race management organizer.
- Unethical behavior was found out of one sponsor. This sponsor placed its own PR materials at the starting point and on the closing stage without our notice.
- The missing water from sponsor was realized immediately after the running ends.
- The minor mistake of opening event found from the MC and opening speech.
- Initially, some mistake of procedure from finance to receive the receipt from registration process.

Recommend the area(s) for improvement of this activity.

- To make the registration process more efficient, the options of application methods should be reduced. Therefore, the number of applicants could be monitored real time.
- The agreement with suppliers should be clearly mentioned about the compensation in case of the delayed delivery.
- The outside organizer should be called for the meeting in advance to ensure the good cooperation and understanding throughout the event sequence.
- Also, the sponsorship agreement should be written noticeably about the penalty of any unethical behaviors that may occur.
