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Executive Summary

The Institute for Research and Academic Services (IRAS) conducted an assessment project on AU students' ethics development after completing the Ethics Seminars and Ethics Course on each semester of academic year 2024, a total of 3,580 respondents participated. The conclusions are as follows:

1. The evaluation results of AU students' ethical development after completing the Ethics Seminars and Ethics Course were at a high level, with an average score of 4.00 out of a full score of 5.

2. The evaluation results of AU students' moral development after completing the Ethics Seminars and Ethics Course, categorized by school, are as follows:.

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Introduction

Rationale

Ethics Seminar and Ethics course are educating ethics among undergraduate students throughout their studies. Information, formation, and transformation are three main concerns.

Project Objective

Four Stages of Training

- 1. Knowing : Ethics as theory
- 2. Doing : Ethics as practice
- 3. Being : Ethics as character
- 4. Living : Ethics as life

Four Years of Training

Students are divided into 4 main groups: freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors. Each group is expected to learn different sets of learning outcome. At the end of their studies each student is supposed to have acquired all established learning outcome.

Population and Sample

The target population for this survey is undergraduate students of AU. The total number of respondents was 3,580.

Data Collection

The researchers collected data using an online questionnaire.

Scoring and Interpretation

The outcomes of the Ethics Seminars and Ethics Course Development Assessment are measured by the mean scores that users assign to the AU community's efforts in establishing and implementing policies that aid students in developing their ethics. The mean score intervals are interpreted as follows:
